## Food and Beverage Policy

### 1.0 Purpose:

To maintain an environment conducive to the pursuits of the College community

### 2.0 Revision History:

This is a revision of an existing policy. (*LFCC Student Handbook: Fall 2005-06*).

### 3.0 Applicability

This policy applies to all students, faculty, administrators, staff, and visitors to LFCC campuses and centers.

### 4.0 Policy

- Food and beverages are permitted in common areas of the College, unless otherwise prohibited.
- Food and beverages are permitted in classrooms, at the discretion of each instructor.
- No food or beverages are permitted in science laboratories, unless the instructor grants permission.
- No food is permitted at computer workstations in classrooms. Covered beverages are permitted at computer workstations in classrooms.

### 5.0 Definitions

### 6.0 Responsibilities

- All persons are responsible for adhering to this policy.
- Buildings and Grounds will post signs, conspicuous to public viewing, in areas where food and beverages are prohibited.
- The Office of the Financial and Administrative Services Office will designate prohibited common areas of the College.
- All persons are responsible for cleaning up any mess they create.

## **7.0 Procedures**

- It is expected that all members of the College community and visitors to the College's facilities will comply with the terms of this policy.
- When individuals are found to be not in compliance, any member of the College community is asked to inform the individual about the terms of the policy.

## **8.0 Sanctions**

Failure to comply with the terms of this policy will result in disciplinary action by the appropriate College official.

## **9.0 Interpretation**

Authority for interpretation of this policy rests with the Vice President of Student Success.
