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Student Code of Conduct Steering Committee

1.0 Purpose

To establish a process for the creation and revision of the College's student code of conduct that provides for behavioral expectations of students and visitors while at the College.

2.0 Revision History

This is a new policy.

3.0 Applicability

This policy applies to all students, faculty, administrators, and staff who create and/or revise and advertise the student code of conduct.

4.0 Policy

This policy grants the office of student success the authority to create and revise the College's student code of conduct.

5.0 Definitions

Student code of conduct -- the document governing LFCC student and student visitor conduct.

6.0 Procedures

The vice president of student success or his/her designee will appoint a Student Code of Conduct Steering Committee for every academic year. The steering committee will be comprised of the Coordinator of Student Life and Student Services, two (2) faculty members – one from the Fauquier Campus and one from the Middletown Campus, two (2) staff representatives, one (1) Student Success

representative, and at least one (1) student representative. The vice president of student success will serve in an advisory capacity.

The steering committee will meet annually and more often if necessary to create and revise the student code of conduct.

The steering committee will seek input, as necessary, from constituents.
